

You will be asked to prove your identity on the day of the exam and upon collection of your certificate. Each candidate is obliged to prove their identity using one of the following document, no other documents will be accepted.

You will not be allowed to take an exam or collect your certificate without satisfactory means of identity.

Please check the type of identity documents we accept for Cambridge English exams:

	Candidates ABOVE 15 years of age	Candidates UNDER 15 years of age
Czech and Slovak citizens	passport / driving licence / ID card	passport / transport season ticket with a photo
European citizens	passport / ID card	passport / ID card
Foreign nationalities	passport	passport

Non EU citizens taking an exam for UK visa purposes must use passport, any other form of ID will NOT be accepted.

If you If you are not able to produce satisfactory proof of identity (loss/theft of ID), please send us an e-mail to info@britishcouncil.cz at least 1 week before your exam and collection of certificate. You will be asked to fill in 'Candidate Identification Form' (part A and B), provide two passport size photographs and arrange an independent witness who confirms your identity.
